

## ANGLING

### Lough Doire Bhile – Glengoole, Thurles, Co Tipperary.

Nestled under the picturesque Slieveardagh Hills, a mile from the village of new Birmingham better known as Glengoole is the superb angling lake of Lough Doire Bhile. Undoubtedly a gem in Tipperary's hidden corner, it is a must for all angling enthusiasts. Renowned for its abundance of sizeable brown trout it is also regularly stocked with hand selected Rainbow trout from 1lbs upwards. Developed in 1994 by Slieveardagh Rural Development this project has been upgraded to facilitate wheelchair assessable fishing bays and boasts two sturdy fishing huts. This peaceful haven of tranquillity boasts stunning scenery and is host to rare flora specimens and is a Mecca for wildlife. The water quality of this remote unspoilt spring fed lake is exceptional. With depths of up to 12ft, an island feature and a naturalised shoreline, it offers top quality sport for fly fishers of all skill levels. The sport is superb and the chance of a big one is always there. A car park services the site. Lough Doire Bhile is worthwhile visit all year round. **Don't let this one get away!**

#### Directions

The easiest way to get to it is to travel north from Killenaule until you reach New Birmingham (Glengoole). Turns left at the crossroads in the village and then take the next left. The road is straight and the left turn is about 3km down this road and is signposted. When you turn left, you go about 400m and you'll see the parking area. In front of you you'll see the lake.
